Key stage 1 tests: 2019 English reading test materials ...
Keystage 1. SATs Key Stage 1 comprises of Year 1 and Year 2 and pupils ' ages range from 5-7. This Key Stage normally covers pupils in infant school, but they can also form part of a first or primary school. There is a phonics screening done at the end of Year 1, but the main assessment is done at the end of Year 2. There are two elements to statutory assessments at the end of Year 2, a combination of tests and teacher assessment judgements.

Key Stage 1 SATs - School Entrance Tests
KS1 SATs papers (often called Year 2 SATs) are tests children take at the end of Year 2. SATs papers KS1 are taken in English Reading , Maths and SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar). KS1 SATs papers is the contracted form of "Key Stage 1 SATs papers" and children take these tests in Year 2.

Children taking Key Stage 1 SATs may also sit two separate papers in grammar, spelling and punctuation: Paper 1: a 20-word spelling test taking approximately 15 minutes and worth 20 marks. Paper 2: a grammar, punctuation and vocabulary test, in two sections of around 10 minutes each (with a break between, if necessary), worth 20 marks.

In 2016/17 English comprised of four tests - Grammar & Punctuation, Spelling and two Reading papers. Maths will comprised of an arithmetic and reasoning paper.

Similarly, it was confirmed on 14 September 2017, that Key Stage 1 SATs will be made non-statutory (schools will be able to choose whether they want to take it) in 2023. Until then all Year 2 pupils will be subject to these assessments. Most noteworthy is that the content of these assessments is prescribed by the National Curriculum. Keystage 2. Key Stage 2 consists of Years 3-6 and pupils ' ages range from 7-11.
