The overall mortality rate in the UK was 614 per 100 000 children which was significantly higher than that in Sweden (328; $p < 0.001$). The mortality rates for the three main causes of death in the UK (prematurity, congenital malformations and infections) were 138.5, 112.1 and 63.9, respectively, per 100 000 children.

We analyzed Demographic and Health Survey data from 24 of USAID's maternal and child survival priority countries to examine care-seeking sources, variations by demographics like socioeconomic status, and differences in treatment by source. Across countries, we found that both public (51%) and private (42%)

There are vast disparities in care-seeking levels between the poorest and wealthiest families as well as stark differences in source, with the poorest often more likely to use non-clinical sources. For example, stakeholders in Myanmar examined differences in care seeking by socioeconomic status and considered how public sector resources might be better targeted towards the poorest and most vulnerable mothers. Policy changes such as this would help close care-seeking disparities and increase

Conducting research is an essential first step, but advocating for the results and collaborating with those in a position to drive change is fundamental in order to translate data into action and advance the health of children and families.
